Mr. Mohoni is the founder of Trendwatch (India) Pvt. Ltd. He is rated as India's foremost market strategist by many investors. Deepak popularised the use of technical analysis with his pioneering columns in the Economic Times and Business World. He has appeared on several television channels including ET Now, BBC, CNBC TV18, NDTV Profit, Zee Business, Aaj Tak, Star TV and Doordarshan.
