Following major events were organized by Bangalore chapter

1. **IIT Kanpur Alumni & CXO meet** was organized on **1<sup>st</sup> July 2017** at The Paul Hotel Bangalore. The main motivation of the event was to bring key Alumni in Bangalore and Director of IIT Kanpur together to collaborate.
